

Skilled Volunteer Expression of Interest

WHQ is a not-for-profit organisation whose purpose is to advance the health and wellbeing of all Queensland (Qld) women. Our head office is in Stones Corner, Brisbane and we maintain a state-wide footprint through partnering with local organisations and leveraging technology. Our vision is that all women have safe and inclusive communities in which they are resourced to live their best lives.

We:

- Are woman-centred – Supporting individual women through health and trauma counselling, recovery from domestic violence and sexual assault, technology-based midwifery care, and a state-wide telephone service that provides information, referral, and support. We also offer therapeutic group classes.
- Build capability of organisations that support women through education and training, research, and partnerships.
- Influence change in communities through primary prevention of violence and gender equity programs.

Position Description:

WHQ has several volunteer positions focused on working with women who are recovering from trauma or needing support. There are also positions available for volunteer administration or reception roles. The position will be adaptable based on your professional skills and availability.

Position Requirements:

This is a woman identified position for our new Women's Centre in Stones Corner. All volunteers will need to have, or apply for, a Blue Card. If applicable you will need to be registered and have your own insurance to practice. Below is a list of professionals that WHQ is looking for:

- **Health Professionals** – For example, but not limited to: general practitioners, nurses, midwives, physiotherapists, osteopaths, massage therapists, acupuncturists, naturopaths, nutritionists.
- **Group facilitators** – For example, but not limited to: art therapists, weaving, yoga, dance, singing, circus, personal trainers or fitness instructors.
- **Legal or Accounting/Finance professionals** - to support women with individual legal or financial advice
- **Administration/ Reception professionals** - to welcome and greet women entering our centre or to provide administrative support to staff.

Women's Health Queensland welcomes all applications and encourages diversity. We value differences in age, culture, life experience and ability. We encourage applications from Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people. We also encourage applications from LGBTQIAP+ people. Diversity makes us stronger.

Benefits:

As part of your volunteer induction we are offering a free professional development course in trauma recovery work.
