

# Introduction to equity and gendered violence

## Purpose

This short course is the first in a series of training programs designed to build knowledge of domestic, family, sexual violence and assault, their impact on families and society, and how they can be prevented. The introductory module explores: current facts, language and terminology; groups affected by DFVSA; the gendered drivers of violence; gender equity; your role in prevention; how to recognise and respond. The course is designed for administrators, frontline staff such as housing, child protection, justice, health workers, volunteers and any member of the workforce or community at-large.
