What do we do at WHQ:

- WHQ provides trauma informed healing centred counselling and therapeutic groups for women who have experienced gender-based violence.
- WHQ supports individual women, co-designs programs with women, listens to women and responds to their needs, and supports others to provide woman-centred approaches.
- WHQ focuses on influencing change in communities through primary prevention of violence and gender equity programs.
- WHQ actively builds the capability of organisations that support women through education and training, research, and partnerships.

***Who is the right student?***

- A proactive student who is keen to engage in WHQ program development and service delivery.
- An independent student who can work with line supervision to ensure identified goals will be met.
- A student passionate about working within the Domestic Family and Sexual Violence sector.
- A student who is comfortable working in a pro-choice organisation.
- A student in their final placement with an existing skill base.

***Areas of direct client contact:***

- Therapeutic groups (Art therapy, shark cage, Mindfulness for anxiety and depression)
- Educational groups (healthy relationships)
- Phone contact on the health and wellbeing line (client calls)
- Case management
- Participant engagement in feedback and program design

***Areas of organisational, sector and practical engagement***

- Operational development (counselling manual, resource development)
- Stakeholder engagement and development (resource manual, agency connections)
- Program design
- Policy and procedure development
- Grant writing large and small.
