What would be required of members?

- Participation in the reference group meetings, every 3 months (in person or via zoom if needed)
- Sharing of your knowledge, insights and understanding of women's and people with diverse genders needs
- On occasion WHQ may engage the reference group for input outside of the 3 monthly meetings.

What will members receive?

- We value your time and input and members will be reimbursed with a gift card for attendance at each meeting.
- Opportunities to attend WHQ training and community events
- Possibilities to inform policy submissions that relate to gendered violence and women's health
- An opportunity to inform how WHQ deliver services including areas of improvement

WHQ encourage participation from Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander peoples, Culturally and Linguistically Diverse people, people living with a disability and members of LGBTIQ+ communities.
